GO Finish 2020 is a truly Kingdom opportunity where the Church of God is joining with other outreach ministries and denominations to simultaneously share Jesus around the world in the same month! For this effort, we are joining hands with Global Outreach Day, an evangelistic ministry that is spearheading this worldwide movement.

Our General Overseer, Dr. Tim Hill is asking all pastors and churches to join together in the month of May 2020 for a grand, combined evangelistic event. Each church may pick a day in the month of May to share Jesus with the lost in their community. Many local churches have selected May 23, 2020 but the dates are flexible for every church.

In Illinois, we will embrace this special event as a way to bring hope and change to our communities. You will see and hear reports about our local events. We ask that you share your plans with the rest of the State. Social media is an excellent format for sharing these stories. 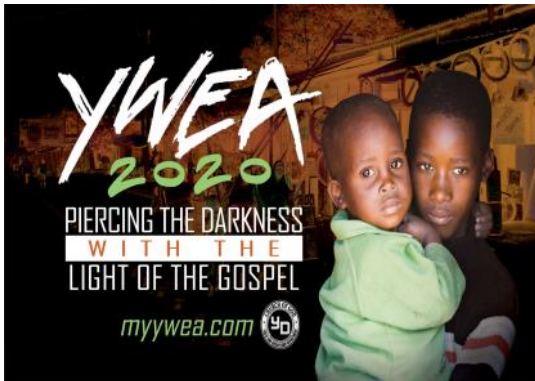
